RACER CRUISER



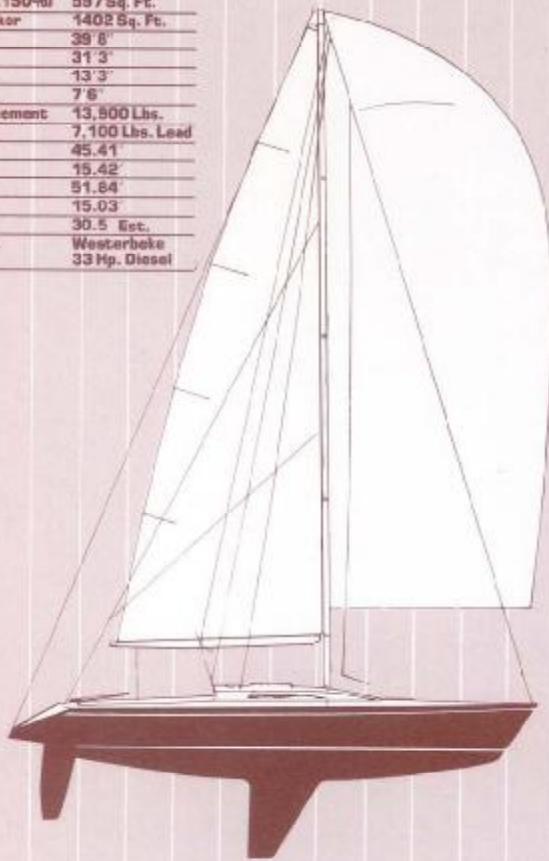
Prospective owners of a boat this size are faced with the unenviable task of choosing between a "cruising" boat which can seriously compromise sailing characteristics and a "racer" with associated draft and accommodation problems.

The Garrett 40, designed by Bruce Farr & Associates, has exceptional performance whether winning races or simply enjoying the thrill of sailing a thoroughbred. Sailing fast is fun, sailing slow is tedious. She is an extremely attractive yacht with a low sheer and coach roof. Meticulously engineered, she is built to the scrutiny of the most serious offshore sailor.

Below she profits from her generous sail carrying beam and Garrett's determination to provide a spacious, finely crafted interior. She has a warm, woody interior with contrasting teak and light woods combined with fine fabrics. There is ample ventilation with ten opening ports and five hatches. Seaton/Neville, well known for their bluewater cruising boats, have designed the interior not only to be luxurious but to make good sense in a seaway. Features include a generous owners stateroom aft, a well thought out galley, two heads with showers for added privacy, and an airy main salon for dining and entertaining. There is copious amounts of storage with large lockers, bins and shelves. The G-40's standard equipment list consists of the finest names in the industry.

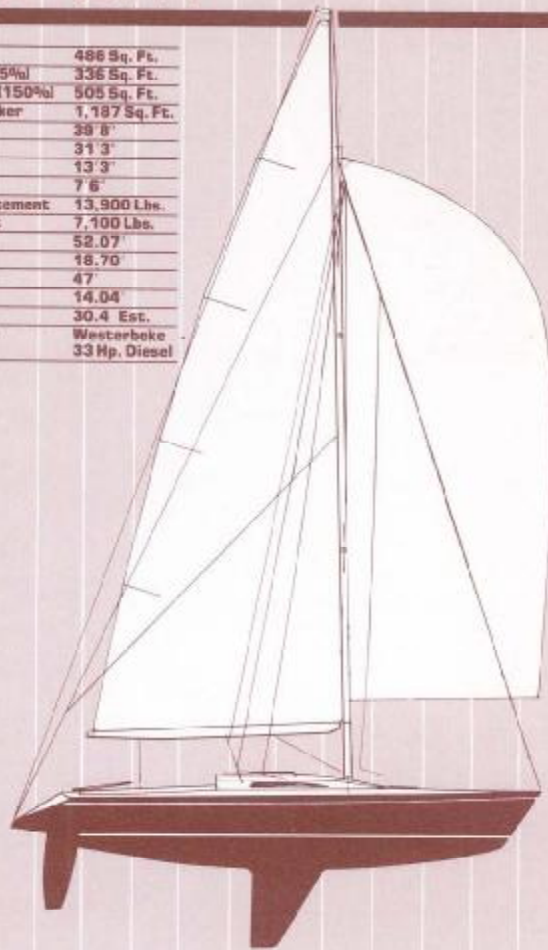

The G-40 GPR is built with the highest level of race proven technology and thoroughly engineered to withstand the rigors of offshore racing. She is built with care for enduring quality.

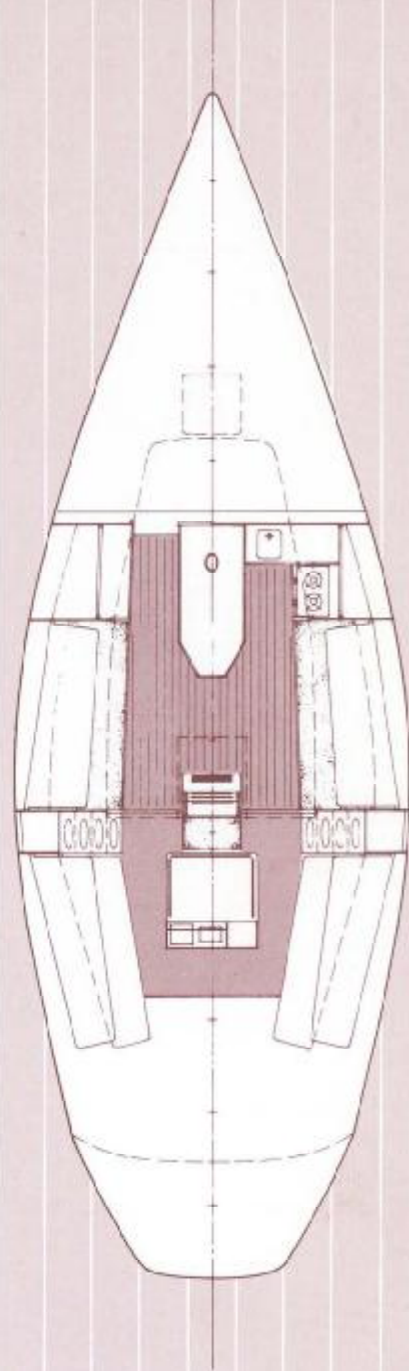
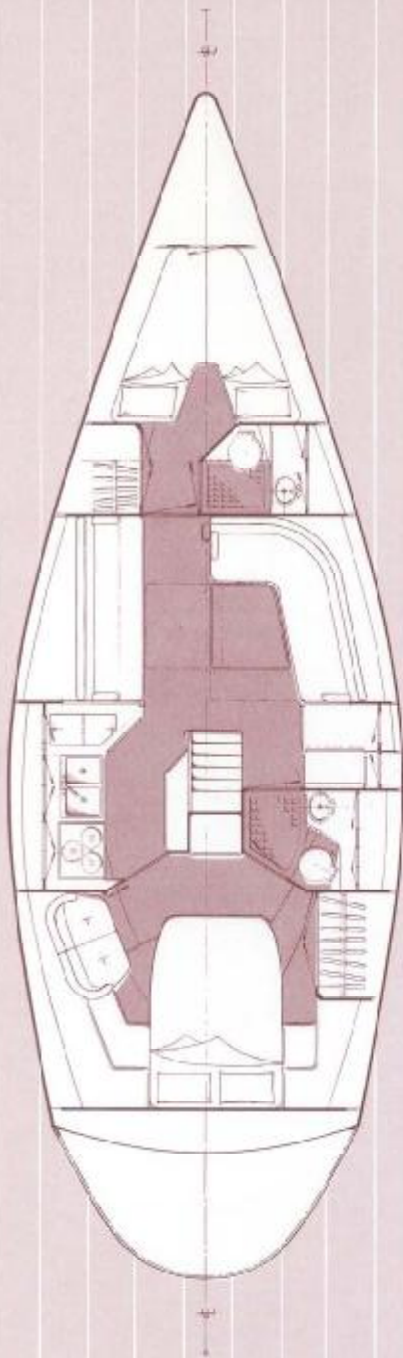
